

Iowa Ranch Horse Association Walk/Trot Entry Form

An exhibitor 10 years of age and under as of January 1 of the current show year is eligible to show in the Walk/Trot Division for young and inexperienced riders. An adult may coach and assist in pattern classes. No touching of reins or horse will be permitted, unless required for safety reasons, then the judge will score accordingly. An exhibitor in the Walk/Trot Division must show in only that division. Walk/Trot contestants will not compete in any cattle classes. There is no payback or point tracking. Ribbons will be awarded at each show.
