Points will be awarded at each show and tracked throughout the year. A one-time (per year) nomination fee of **\$10 per division** must be submitted to be eligible for year-end awards. Points will accumulate <u>AFTER</u> the nomination fee is paid. Points will be posted on the IRHA website (iowaranchhorse.com).

(A) Open - points will be kept on the horse.

(B) Amateur, Novice Amateur, Sr. Youth, and Jr. Youth - points will be kept on the horse/exhibitor combination.

(C) Walk/Trot – No year end points will be calculated.

<u>Year-end Class Champions</u> will be selected for each class in each division. Points will be calculated in each individual class. There will be no minimum number of shows required. **ANY** exhibitor that has nominated for year-end awards will be eligible for year-end individual class awards in **each class** in their division, regardless of whether or not they meet All-Around requirements.

<u>All-Around Awards</u> will be calculated in each division. A **Year-end Ranch Horse All-Around Champion** and Reserve Champion will be selected and prizes awarded in each division with additional awards depending the number of entries.

To be eligible for All -Around Ranch Horse awards in their division, the exhibitor will designate six (6) classes (dropping any one of the offered classes) in which points will be tracked for an All-Around Award. An exhibitor is not required to compete in all six (6) designated classes. An exhibitor may compete in all seven (7) classes, but only the six (6) predesignated classes will be tracked for All-Around points.
